



With the new version 2026.1, we are expanding evaexam with several exciting new features to help you implement your exam projects. The content of this new release focuses on two key areas: First, we are building on the evaexam 2025.1 release and continuing to make the dispatch of results to participants more flexible. Second, we are introducing a new feature for setting up individualized disadvantage compensation, which makes it easy to meet legal requirements for equal opportunity for exam participants.

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Create/import participants with disadvantage compensation

In evaexam version 2026.1, individual or multiple participants who are legally entitled to disadvantage compensation in online exams can be created or imported with a different time limit for the online exam. This allows individuals with and without disadvantage compensation to take the same exam without the need to create a separate exam. The exam itself can thus be administered and graded entirely within evaexam.

How does it work?

The CSV import for participants includes an additional column for extra minutes. Here, you can enter a specific value in minutes to be added to the standard exam duration. The form for manually creating or editing participant data now also includes an additional field where this value can be entered. If needed, this value can be set individually for each exam and participant.

Conduct an online exam with disadvantage compensation

An exam that includes disadvantage compensation for participants is conducted in the same way as any other online exam with a time limit. The participants in question automatically receive the specified extra time for the exam. Examiners do not need to take any further action. This saves time and effort, as all participants are added to a single exam, meaning only one email invitation is sent to everyone. The online exam itself is accessible in accordance with WCAG 2.2 AA and can be supported by assistive technologies such as screen readers.

 **How does it work?**

If participants with extended time limits have been imported for an online exam, the extra minutes available will be clearly displayed on the exam's start page for the participants. The exam dashboard also displays the extra minutes for examiners to review. When participants enter the exam, the exam time is extended by the additional minutes, and the progress bar displays the total time available.

Grade the exam with disadvantage compensation

Once the exam is complete, the entire exam is evaluated; that is, all participant data is included in the generated reports. For documentation purposes, the score export now includes the exam's time limit as additional information.

How does it work?

Once you have completed the exam and, if applicable, graded the open-ended questions, open the exam details and click on "Scores in CSV format." The CSV file available for download will now include an additional column showing the time limit for all participants (with and without disadvantage compensation).

Customizable email text for results dispatch

When sending out exam results to participants after the exam has been conducted, examiners can now view the email text and customize it on their own. This results in significantly greater transparency and flexibility, as the email text could previously only be controlled centrally.

How does it work?

When you click "Send student reports to participants," the advanced sending menu will open. In the upper part of the window, you can edit the sender information, subject line, and email text before sending.

New placeholders for the email text

When sending exam results to participants, you can now use additional placeholders within the email text to directly embed the exam results into the email. This allows you to quickly and easily communicate the relevant information about the exam results to participants.

In addition to the email form, a checkbox labeled "Attach single student report as a PDF" will be displayed. If this is deactivated, the emails will be sent without an attachment. Please note that in this case, the information regarding the exam results should be included in the email body using placeholders.

Search field for the subunit list
